INSTITUTION'S CODE OF CONDUCT

Code of Conduct for Students

- Students are expected to engage in thoughtful and meaningful dialogue while interacting with teachers.
- Students should provide constructive feedback on the quality of teaching and learning experience in the campus.
- Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited in college campus. All the students should take anti-ragging undertaking.
- Any student aggrieved by any acts of sexual harassment, misconduct or ragging can approach the Grievance Redressal Cell of the institution. In addition, if any violations are noticed that must be brought to the notice of the Cell.
- All students must deter from doing discrimination on any basis and avoid indulging in any forms of misconduct.
- Students should avoid intentionally damaging property of institution, other students and faculty members.
