The institution is affiliated to Bangalore University, Bengaluru and it is recognized by the University Grants Commission (UGC) under section 2(f) & 12(B) under Act, 1956. It is also recognized & approved by Govt. of Karnataka and National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE), to offer B.Ed. course and accredited by National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) with "B" Grade on 5th January 2013.

The Grant-in-aid was also extended to the college from 2009 by the department of Public Instruction, Government of Karnataka. The word 'Sarvajna' signifies simplicity, skill, and efficiency of highly resourceful energetic and enterprising teams of dedicated and morally sound teachers and students. Faculty is having sufficient teaching experience in the field of teacher education.

Sri Sarvajna, the maintenance of quality and standard are possible because of the dedicated, committed Principal and faculty. The college offers two years Bachelor of Education (B.Ed) course for those who have completed their graduation with minimum aggregate of 50% from any recognized university are eligible to apply for this course.

Students here are admitted who have completed their graduation from recognized university with at least 50% marks in major or in aggregate at the Degree level. But Scheduled Castes (S.C.), Scheduled Tribes (S.T.) & (O.B.C) candidates are to be entitled with a relaxation 5% marks ineligibility for admission

Code of Conduct

Purposes of Code of Conduct at Teacher Education Institute:

The code of conduct of the institution generally serves the following purposes

1. To foster a culture of high standards of honesty, integrity, ethical and law-abiding behaviour among teacher educators and student-teachers
2. To encourage the observance of standards among teacher educators to protect and promote the interests of students and the institution
3. To set out the responsibility and accountability of teacher educators as well as student teachers to report and investigate any reported violations of the code or unethical or unlawful behaviour
4. To instruct teacher educators and student teachers about the standards of the teacher education institute.
5. To enable the teacher educators to deal consistently and fairly with all students in the classroom.
6. To ensure that teachereducators with student teachers are interacting professionally and vice versa
7. To make the disciplinary process to solve the issues without aggravating the situation when unethical behaviour occurs

8. To serve as an instrument of self-regulation by acknowledging a responsibility on the part of teachereducators for the work that they do
